














UNITED WAY PARTNERING WITH GOOD DADS

When James was released from prison after a battle with addiction, he knew he needed to rebuild his relationship with his two sons. He joined the New Pathways for Good Dads program, a program partially funded by United Way of the Ozarks.

Through the Good Dads program, James learned how to reconnect with his kids, one conversation at a time. The program empowered him to make strides in his personal life and as a parent.

Today, James is thriving. He works a great job with benefits. He proudly provides for his sons, and sees them as often as possible for their favorite activities like fishing, putt-putt or hiking.

His kids are so grateful to have their "Good Dad" back in their lives.

THE NEED

23% of children in Missouri have an identified mental. emotional or behavioral health challenge, and childhood abuse and neglect continue to be pervading red flags in our area.

United Way invests in programs ensuring children have the tools they need to reach their full potential. We help youth achieve milestones in development, education and health.

Through United Way donors last year, 2,705 youth were supported by a consistent, caring adult relationship.

THE NEED

We're facing a critical shortage of safe, affordable housing. In the last 5 years, housing costs have increased by 73%. Poor mental health and substance abuse are also prevalent challenges in the Ozarks region.

WHAT WE DO

United Way provides pathways out of poverty through workforce development, stable housing, financial literacy and quality healthcare.

OUR IMPACT

Through United Way donors last vear. 658 unhoused individuals were moved to stable housing, and 3,155 people received mental health counseling, regardless of ability to pay.
